OCH02 - BAMBOO RAFTING ON THE MARTHA BRAE



DURATION: APPROX. 5 HOURS | PRICE: \$79 PER ADULT, \$56 PER CHILD

Venture to one of the most picturesque places in Jamaica, the “Land of Wood and Water”, for a unique Jamaican experience. Enjoy a countryside drive along the coast; see the rural lifestyle of Jamaica en route to the Martha Brae rafting center where you will be greeted with a welcome tropical drink on arrival. Picture yourself on a bamboo raft built for two, gliding slowly down a river that meanders gently through whispering groves of bamboo and ferns. As the raft makes its way past shaded banks and dappled sunlight and the mild river breeze washes over you, hear the story of the “Matibereon” as you float along the river, relaxing in an atmosphere of tranquility. Arriving at the Rafter’s Rest, the bus awaits for the return trip to Ocho Rios. The final stop on your excursion takes you to Taj Mahal Shopping Centre for a chance to browse for that perfect souvenir to remind you of your visit to Ocho Rios.

Please note: The raft carries two passengers and is guided by an expert raftsmen. Insect repellent is advisable.

OCH26 – GOLF AT UPTON GOLF COURSE



DURATION: APPROX. 5.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$175 PER ADULT, \$123 PER CHILD

The course at the Sandals Golf & Country Club, formerly the Upton Golf Club, provides a formidable test for even the most skilled golfers. The 18-hole golf course stretches out over heavily undulating terrain that is covered in dense vegetation including verdant fruit trees and exotic tropical flowers. Out-of-bounds stakes and strategically placed bunkers spread throughout require precision and strategy. Small, sloped greens and a topography that plays mostly uphill provide additional challenge. More than just a difficult golf course, golfers can also enjoy panoramic ocean and mountain vistas. The Sandals Golf & Country Club also offers practice facilities including a putting green and driving range.

Please note: To avoid disappointment, guests are requested to follow the Golf Club’s strict dress code: Jeans are not allowed. Proper attire includes a collared shirt, tailored non-denim shorts or pants/slacks with sport socks and golf shoes. No halter top, or bathing suits allowed. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English. Price of the tour includes Green fee, shared golf cart, use of the practice facility and golf club rental.

OCH28 - KAYAKING & DUNN’S RIVER FALLS



DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$102 PER ADULT, \$72 PER CHILD

Enjoy a short drive in air-conditioned comfort to Dolphin Cove, where you are met by our friendly hostesses and given a complimentary fruit drink. After a brief orientation – and being fitted with your life vest – enter your Kayak to take a guided journey on the Crystal Clear Caribbean Sea to Dunn’s River Falls. You will be amazed and fascinated at the underwater world and its spectacular beauty. See the wonders of waterfalls and enjoy fantastic photo opportunities on your way to Dunn’s River Falls. As you approach Dunn’s River, enjoy a truly spectacular view of the Caribbean’s most famous waterfall. Upon arrival at the world famous Dunn’s River Falls, your friendly hostesses will lead you to your capable guides who will assist you in climbing the 600 feet of cool refreshing water as it cascades over natural limestone terraces. After this invigorating experience you are transported back to Dolphin Cove by bus (approx. 5 mins.) where you can learn about Jamaican culture and enjoy the amenities. Shuttle buses are available at 10-minute intervals to return you to the ship and optional shopping at your convenience.

Please Note: We recommend comfortable clothing, comfortable shoes, water shoes to climb the falls, swimwear, change of clothes, towels and sunscreen. Lockers are available for rent at both Dunn’s River Falls and Dolphin Cove. This Tour is not recommended for pregnant women, people with back or neck injuries, or heart and respiratory conditions. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a paying adult. Guests wishing to climb the falls must be at least 92 cm/3 ft. in height. Guests will not be permitted to jump from the falls.

OCH29HOL – OCHO RIOS & DUNN’S RIVER FALLS WITH VEGAN LUNCH



DURATION: APPROX. 5.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$92 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD

Time to leave the ship and visit one of Jamaica’s premiere attractions, the gorgeous Dunn’s River Falls near Ocho Rios, which you’ll reach after a scenic drive. A plaque provided by the Jamaican Historical Society marks the spot as the site of



the battle of Las Chorreras, fought by the English and the Spanish over land rights in 1657 – with the English as the victors. The land was ultimately acquired by the Jamaican government in 1972, since which time it has served locals and visitors alike as a popular recreational area and park. The spring water that feeds the falls is rich in calcium carbonate, which results in deposits of travertine and makes the falls a self-regenerating “living” phenomenon. After a drive to the Dunn’s River, your guide will lead you up the naturally terraced river bed as part of a human chain. The climb includes a short pause at the so-called “massage parlour”, where the cascading water can soothe tired shoulders. As an alternative to the climb, there are safe spots from which to watch the others ascend the falls. Next up is a tasty vegan buffet lunch by the sea, after which a sightseeing drive around Ocho Rios rounds off the tour before you return to the ship.

Please note: Guests are recommended to wear swimwear under comfortable clothing, high-factor sunscreen and to bring a towel plus a change of clothing if swimwear is not worn at the waterfall. Slip-proof or water shoes should be worn since climbing the falls’ many terraced steps is both strenuous and very slippery. Guests wishing to climb the falls must be at least 92 cm/3 ft. in height. Guests will not be permitted to jump from the falls.

OCH31 - HORSEBACK RIDE & SWIM 

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD

After leaving the ship and boarding an air-conditioned coach, this equestrian excursion begins with a scenic drive along the beautiful Jamaican coastline to reach the stables where you will saddle up prior to going for a ride. Experienced guides will accompany your horseback experience, providing information on the island’s rich history, culture, flora and fauna on the way. Look forward to enjoying the fresh breeze in your face and breathtaking views of the Caribbean Sea as you travel towards Chukka Beach for the water-based leg of the tour. After your mounts have been unsaddled by your guides, you can then ride bareback right into the Caribbean Sea – a swimming experience like no other. To round off the outing, there will be time for you to visit the gift shop. Cold drinks and jerk chicken are also available for purchase at the bar and grill. A scenic return journey to the ship brings the tour to a close.

Please note: Guests must be at least 6 years of age, weigh no more than 250 lbs. and will be required to sign a waiver form, which may only be available in English, to take part in the tour. The tour is not suitable for pregnant women.

OCH32 - BOBSLED JAMAICA & FALLS 

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$95 PER ADULT, \$67 PER CHILD

Board your air-conditioned transportation for the brief drive to Dunn’s River Falls. Upon arrival follow the local guide as they lead you up the 600 feet of cascading and slippery falls that empty into the Caribbean Sea. After this refreshing and exciting climb return to the transportation for the short drive to Mystic Mountain. Embark the Sky Explorer chairlift for a fun ride up 700 feet through the tropical forest canopy. At the peak spend a few minutes exploring the interesting educational displays about the history and culture of Jamaica and her people. Next, get ready for the thrill of your life on the one and only Jamaica Bobsled adventure ride. After an orientation embark your specially made bobsled and hold on as it plunges through 2780 feet of twists and turns down the mountain. After coming to a controlled stop, you are lifted back to the top on an elevated tramway. Admire the panoramic views. Hop a ride on the Sky Explorer chairlift back to the bottom.

Please note: Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English. Wear sturdy rubber-soled shoes or bring a pair with you if you choose to climb Dunn’s River Falls. Please be advised that the Falls can be very slippery in places. Jumping from the falls is not permitted. Bring a swimsuit and towel; lockers are available at the falls for a nominal fee. Children must be at least 54” in height to ride the bobsled without being accompanied by a paying adult. Guests wishing to climb the falls must be at least 92 cm/3 ft. in height. A maximum weight restriction of 127 kg / 280 lb applies. The order of the tour may be reversed.

OCH34 – DUNN’S RIVER FALLS EXPRESS 

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$59 PER ADULT, \$39 PER CHILD

Leave the ship for a while and venture out to one of Jamaica’s most popular natural wonders, the Dunn’s River Falls near Ocho Rios, which you’ll reach by coach. The waterfall is fed by spring water with a high concentration of calcium carbonate, which leaves deposits of a rock called travertine. As a result, the falls is a living – and growing – phenomenon. Once at the falls and following a safety briefing, you’ll form a human chain and be led up the naturally terraced river bed



by your experienced guide. Then enjoy a stop at the so-called “massage parlour” and experience the soothing effect of the cascading water on its way to the sea. For a more leisurely look at the falls, you can also spend the time comfortably seated on the terrace or deck and simply watch the proceedings. The surrounding forest, by contrast, provides the perfect setting for a walk through tropical vegetation including ferns, bamboo, ginger lilies, orchids, palms and breadfruit trees. Your return to the ship brings the tour to an end.

Please note: Guests are recommended to bring a towel as well as to wear high-factor sunscreen, swimwear and non-skid water shoes, since climbing the many steps of the falls is both strenuous and slippery. Water shoes are available for hire at the waterfall. Guests wishing to climb the falls must be at least 92 cm/3 ft. in height. Guests will not be permitted to jump from the falls.

OCH37 – ALL INCLUSIVE BEACH BREAK   

DURATION: 6 HOURS, LUNCH INCLUDED | PRICE: \$119 PER ADULT, \$64 PER CHILD

Spend your day out relaxing with an all-inclusive experience at the impressive Riu Ocho Rios Resort, a family resort offering a wide selection of restaurants and unlimited alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages at multiple bars. Have fun at the Riu Ocho Rios with your family and friends, lounge by the pool sipping your choice of alcoholic, non-alcoholic, mixed or premium brand drinks. Have a scrumptious lunch of local or international cuisine or go shopping in the gift shop and duty free stores. Whatever your choice to do, your day will end with you feeling refreshed and revived.

Please note: Guests should wear their swimsuit under comfortable clothing and wear flat comfortable shoes. Guests are recommended to bring sun protection and cash for additional purchases.

OCH39HOL – DISCOVER GREEN GROTTA CAVES WITH VEGAN LUNCH  

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$82 PER ADULT, \$66 PER CHILD

Take a scenic drive through the town of Ocho Rios, which is known for its abundant rainfall, verdant landscapes and rolling hills. Other outstanding vistas will be seen along the way, as you travel to Green Grotto Caves, for a touch of adventure, a journey into the underground and a delicious vegan lunch. The caves are situated no more than 1 km from the spot where Christopher Columbus landed in 1494, and the fact that Runaway Caves numbers among their many former names is testament to one of the uses to which they were put in the 18th century. The caverns also provided sanctuary for the Spanish in the 17th century, later facilitated the activities of arms smugglers and were then used to store rum. Impressive dripstone formations such as stalactites and stalagmites, interconnected passages leading to larger chambers and the grotto itself – with a pool of crystal-clear water – are just some of the attractions that go to make this place so special. On your way back to the surface, a stop will be made at the so-called “Wishing Well”, a pool into which you’ll do well to throw a coin, for luck, for love, for anything your heart desires. Once you return to the surface, the coach will be waiting to take you back to your ship in Ocho Rios.

Please note: This tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests with mobility problems.

OCH42 – CATAMARAN SAILAWAY, BEACH & SNORKEL   

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$69 PER ADULT, \$49 PER CHILD

Step aboard the Chukka Catamaran and Sail Away for an unforgettable experience which affords you an unmatched opportunity to be at one with nature. The warm smiles and hospitality of the crew will start your day off right onboard the catamaran. After suiting up with your snorkel equipment, glide majestically through the beautiful turquoise Caribbean Sea and enjoy astounding views of the aquatic world around you. Explore the reefs and be mesmerized by the natural beauty of the mysterious underwater world. Then you’ll arrive at the beach where you can relax on the white sand, enjoy the scenery, or hang out at the beach bar grill. Once you’ve had your fill, re-board the catamaran for the party cruise as the crew teaches you a dance-move or two while you enjoy a signature rum punch. This is the perfect way to enjoy a slice of paradise. Fun for the entire family!

Please note: Change of clothing and swimwear are recommended, should guests decide to go snorkeling. Beverages are included in the tour price however alcohol will not be served before snorkeling. Food and drinks may be purchased at an additional cost at the beach.

The tour begins with an escorted walk from the ship to the pickup point of the catamaran which is about a 5 minute walk; this will also be the drop off point of the catamaran at the end of the tour, at which point you can make your own way back to the ship. Minimum age to



participate to the tour is 6 years. All children between 6-12 years are required to wear life vests. All guests are required to wear life vests when going snorkeling. All guests are to adhere to the safety instructions given by the Captain and crew on board the catamaran at all times. Guests will be tendered to the beach on windy days. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

OCH43 – BOB MARLEY’S NINE MILE

DURATION: APPROX. 5.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$89 PER PERSON

Nine Mile is a mountain village in the parish of St. Ann, a little inland from Jamaica’s northern coastline. So far, so unspectacular – were it not for the fact that Nine Mile happens to be the birth- and final resting place of the king of reggae: Bob Marley. To pay your respects, simply board the air-conditioned coach and enjoy some of the man’s greatest hits as you make your way through Jamaica’s scenic rural countryside to reach your destination. A small Ethiopian-style church houses the marble mausoleum in which Marley’s remains have been entombed along with his guitar. After the visit, you’ll travel via Higgins Town and St. Ann’s Bay to reach the local “jerk” centre for an authentic Jamaican lunch featuring the tasty seasoning. The return journey to the ship then brings the tour to an end.

Please note: Guests must be at least 18 years of age in order to participate. At the Nine Mile gate there may be some Rastafarians selling local items. Once inside the gates of Bob Marley’s birthplace it is quite the Rastafarian paradise. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable shoes with grip as there is some incline to the terrain. This tour is not recommended for guests suffering from back problems. The roads are narrow and winding. Participating guests must be able to climb 75 steps at the Bob Marley location. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

OCH44 –BAMBOO BEACH BREAK

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$25 PER ADULT, \$18 PER CHILD

A short coach ride from the pier is all that separates you from one of the finest stretches of shoreline Ocho Rios has to offer: the Bamboo Beach Club. On arrival, you’ll be met by your guide and shown your complimentary beach chair. Then you’ll be free to chill out in the shade provided by 100-year-old almond trees or seek out a sunny spot by the water to work on your tan. Or take to the water for a refreshing swim, all the while surrounded by glorious views. And lots of reggae music, of course. Time permitting, a quick shopping break is also included on the way back to round off the tour.

Please note: Beachside massages and snorkel gear hire are available at extra cost. Free WiFi is available near the main bar area. Guests are recommended to bring a beach towel, high-factor sunscreen, a camera, and some cash or a credit card to cover additional purchases. Guests are also recommended to wear swimwear under comfortable clothing. Guests must be at least 18 years of age to consume alcohol. Guests wishing to book the tour inclusive of lunch and unlimited drinks are requested to book tour code OCH44A, which is \$59 for adults and \$42 for children. (Dishes will be served “tapas style”).



ARU02 - BUTTERFLY FARM & NATURAL WONDERS

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$62 PER ADULT, \$44 PER CHILD

Experience the full beauty of Natural Aruba on a tour that takes you on a journey of discovery. You will first make the scenic trip to Aruba's number one ecological attraction, The Butterfly Farm. The farm is an unforgettable encounter with nature in all its diversity. Step into a tropical garden teeming with butterflies and prepare to meet some of the world's most colourful and unusual creatures. From the Butterfly Farm you will journey to the Aruba Aloe Balm Facility, where you will take a guided tour and see the production process first hand, from leaf cutting in the fields to finished lotions and creams in the facility. Traveling on, you will pass countless divi divi trees and cacti before arriving at the Natural Bridge. This natural wonder has been carved of solid coral by the relentless pounding of the surf. You will then pass the Gold Mill Ruins at Boca Mahos. The excursion ends with the scenic drive to Oranjestad, the capital of Aruba.

Please note: Please wear comfortable shoes - sandy surfaces.

ARU04 - SEE & SEA ISLAND TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$72 PER ADULT, \$51 PER CHILD

Experience the full beauty of Aruba on a tour that takes you around the island and under the sea! After your air-conditioned bus ride to the pier, you will board the transfer boat for a scenic cruise to the Seaworld Explorer. The Seaworld Explorer is a state-of-the-art semi-submarine that was developed in Australia for use on the Great Barrier Reef. The vessel does not submerge; you descend into the hull of the vessel and sit in air-conditioned comfort five feet below the surface of the water. View amazing sea life in this cruising underwater observatory through large, clear glass windows. The Seaworld Explorer takes you to the wreck of the "Antilla", a 440-foot German freighter destroyed by an explosion that tore the freighter in two halves during World War II. Delight in your incredible surroundings as your skilful captain maneuvers the semi-submarine through the heart of the Caribbean's largest shipwreck. Returning to shore, your guide drives you to the California Lighthouse where you can admire the magnificent view of the crashing waves of the windward coast and the tranquil waters of the leeward shore. From here your bus takes you to the awesome Casibari Rock Formations where you may climb the rock gardens to the top of the highest boulder. You will then visit the Natural Bridge, a bridge of rock formed naturally by the wind and the motion of the sea. Finally, you drive past the Gold Mill Ruins at Boca Mahos and back to Oranjestad, the capital of Aruba.

Please note: Guests must be able to descend 11 steps into the hull of the Seaworld Explorer. Please wear comfortable shoes.

ARU07HOL - TICKET TO PARADISE WITH VEGAN LUNCH

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$69 PER CHILD

The journey to paradise begins with transfers by bus with historical information about Aruba, followed by a ferry ride across the Spanish Lagoon on the remote south part of the island en route to the private reef island, De Palm Island. De Palm Island offers it all: spectacular coral formations, a large variety of tropical fauna, including our friendly blue parrot fish, which can be seen while snorkeling in the crystal clear waters dressed by our white sand pocket beaches, snorkeling, a water slide attraction, banana boat ride, zip lining, air-jumping, sunbathing, relaxing, buffet and open bar. Enjoy our spectacular new state of the art "Blue Parrot" water park with six breath-taking water slides to get your adrenaline going. Changing rooms and exterior showers are available. A sumptuous Caribbean lunch buffet, including a variety of vegan options, and all beverages are included.

Please Note: Towel, sun protection and extra cash for souvenirs are recommended.

ARU11 - SAILING AND SNORKELING

DURATION: APPROX. 3.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$55 PER ADULT, \$39 PER CHILD

This snorkeling tour gives you the chance to marvel at the beauty of Aruba's coastline and marine life. The perfect combination of wind, sun and sailing makes this a fun and relaxing trip. After some smooth sailing, the first stop will be Boca Cathalina for some great reef snorkeling. As the depth will be around 15 feet, it is the perfect place to refresh or learn



snorkeling skills. The second stop will be at the famous “Antilla” shipwreck. A remnant of World War II, the “Antilla” was scuttled by its own captain, to prevent it from being captured by the Dutch Marines. It’s lying on its side in 60 feet of water. Voted as one of the world’s top 10 dive and snorkel sites and being the largest ship in the Caribbean, it’s an experience you won’t forget. After the second stop follows a relaxing sail back to the cruise ship with unlimited rum punch, juice and soda combined with recorder music.

Please note: Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English. Snorkel sites may vary due to surface and weather conditions.

ARU12HOL - ARUBA BEACH TOUR WITH VEGAN SNACK

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$45 PER ADULT, \$40 PER CHILD

Board your open bus amidst Caribbean music and colors and prepare to see the sights that have made Aruba so popular... its spectacular white sandy beaches adorned with all shades of blue!... its turquoise and crystal clear ocean. Stop at Eagle Beach, relax, soak up the sun, and enjoy the ocean breeze. Beach chairs are included at the second beach stop. A vegan snack will be provided. The tour will conclude at the cruise terminal.

Please Note: Wear a swimsuit if you plan to swim, and bring a towel and adequate sun protection. Bringing extra cash is suggested in case guests want to make purchases at the restaurant and bar.

ARU13 - TASTE OF ARUBA

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$52 PER ADULT, \$37 PER CHILD

Meet your guide for the day, board your very comfortable air-conditioned bus and prepare yourself to experience Aruba at its finest. Get a taste of what the island is all about with the background tunes of Aruban Music while driving through charming Oranjestad. Observe the Dutch Colonial architecture, with its antique buildings and houses, merging with its very modern architecture. Your first stop will be the Aloe Factory for a brief description of the Aloe plantation and a tour through the Aloe museum. Then drive through the countryside and discover Aruba’s flora and fauna en route to the Casibari Rock formation, huge diorite boulders found in the center of the island. Then board your bus and drive to the Natural Bridge Ruins and see a different side of the island. Continue your tour through the countryside en route to the California Lighthouse, for a short stop to enjoy the breath-taking panoramic top view of the island. Drive past Aruba’s most beautiful beaches en route to the cruise terminal. Experience Aruba’s greatest assets through our very warm and welcoming people, always ready to share our island and its unique culture and history.

ARU15 - BEST OF ARUBA

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$55 PER ADULT, \$39 PER CHILD

Begin your tour driving through the colourful capital city, Oranjestad, and up to the California Lighthouse, where your driver guide will explain everything about the first inhabitants on Aruba. Next stop will be the Alto Vista Chapel where it’s said that the local Indians were converted to Christians. Head to the north coast and see the collapsed Natural and the Baby Natural Bridge. Your final stop will be the Aloe Factory to view the harvest and the production of Aruba’s aloe vera plant. On your return to the ship you will have the option to be dropped off in town (5 min walking distance to the cruise ship terminal) for shopping or just return to the ship.

Please note: Sun protection and extra cash are suggested for souvenirs.

ARU16 - ATLANTIS SUBMARINE TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 1.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD

Your adventure begins with a short transfer to the submarine onboard our shuttle vessel SubSeeker. Board the submarine just off the southeast coast of Aruba for a thrilling dive to either the mysteriously sunken airplane, or the newly sunken coaster, “The Morgenster”. You will also have the opportunity to get an up close view of exotic marine life while diving to depths up to 130 feet. Be amazed by colourful schools of tropical fish, huge sponge gardens, and the mystical beauties of the coral fields. The educational and entertaining narration of the experienced, professional, and licensed crew will



highlight this unique experience. All of this is in air-conditioned comfort without getting wet!

Please note: Children less than 36 inches in height are not permitted to take part in this tour. A 12-step ladder must be negotiated when descending into the submarine.

ARU18 - SEA WORLD EXPLORER SUBMARINE

DURATION: APPROX. 2 HOURS | PRICE: \$55 PER ADULT, \$39 PER CHILD

The Seaworld Explorer is a state-of-the-art semi-submarine developed in Australia for use on the Great Barrier Reef. The vessel does not submerge; you descend into the hull of this cruising underwater observatory and sit in air-conditioned comfort five feet below the surface of the water, exploring amazing sea life through large, clear glass windows. After your air-conditioned bus ride to the pier, you board a transfer boat that takes you to the Seaworld Explorer. Our skilled captain and knowledgeable narrator guides the semi-submarine to the wreck of the “Antilla”, a 440-foot German freighter destroyed during World War II. The huge ship lies on her side just under the surface of the ocean, providing a home to thousands of colourful fish and corals. Measuring 440 feet in length, this is the largest wreck in the Caribbean. From the wreck, you enjoy a relaxing cruise to shore.

Please note: Guests have to be able to descend 11 steps into the hull of the Seaworld Explorer.

ARU19 - SIGHTSEEING & SWIM TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$52 PER ADULT, \$37 PER CHILD

Thanks to this entertaining half-day tour, exploring the beguiling sights of Aruba has never been easier. Your outing kicks off with an enjoyable drive through Oranjestad, the island’s capital, en route to Aruba’s northern shores for an outside viewing of the California Lighthouse. First lit in 1916, the lighthouse was named after the wreck of a steamship that sank nearby in 1891. Your driver/guide will tell you a little about Aruba’s first inhabitants before you move on to one of the island’s most visited locations: the Baby Natural Bridge, the – now sadly collapsed – Natural Bridge and the amazing Casibari Rock Formation. The size of small houses, these huge rock formations make for fabulous photo moments, so do keep your camera at hand. One of Aruba’s pristine beaches is next, where the soft white sand and clear blue of the water make a perfect setting for just under 1 hour of free time to go swimming or simply laze around and catch the sun. To end the tour, you’ll have a chance to return directly to the ship or be dropped off in town to do some shopping, with only a 5-minute walk back to the cruise terminal when you’re done.

ARU20 - ARUBA TREASURES

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$45 PER ADULT, \$32 PER CHILD

A few of Aruba’s numerous treasures are yours to discover on a varied half-day tour dedicated to delivering only the best. The first destination in this line-up of must-sees is the fascinating Aruba Aloe Museum & Factory, which serves to illustrate the 160-year history of aloe farming in Aruba. Also included on the itinerary are gorgeous views from the top of the huge Casibari Rock Formations in the north of the island as well as a visit to the enchanting Philip’s Animal Garden, home to an array of exotic animals. You’ll have a chance to feed some of the hooved animals that live in the Animal Garden – but only if you wish. The final two stops on the tour will then be at the lovely Alto Vista Chapel, the site at which Aruba’s Christian traditions are said to have been founded, and the early 20th-century California Lighthouse, which carries the name of an unfortunate ship that was wrecked nearby in the late 19th century. Your return to the ship wraps up your Aruba outing.

Please note: Feeding of the animals (hooved livestock only) is optional. As a mark of respect, guests wishing to enter the Roman Catholic chapel are requested to bring/wear appropriate clothing.

ARU21 – CHAMPAGNE BRUNCH: SAIL & SNORKEL

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS, INCL. BREAKFAST & LUNCH | PRICE: \$92 PER ADULT, \$65 PER CHILD

Cut loose from your ship for a few hours and instead enjoy a carefree brunch aboard a custom-built catamaran, complete with sunbathing trampolines, sunbathing spots and shaded areas for your cruising pleasure. Your three snorkeling highlights are located to the north, and as you sail, you can sip a mimosa and savour tempting morsels of delicious food. Your first



stop will be at Catalina Bay, where the white sand beach provides a great starting point to go snorkeling in the shallow water and experience its kaleidoscopic variety of underwater life. Moving on again, your second stop will see you linger a little offshore to view the remains of the Caribbean’s largest underwater shipwreck: the German ES Antilla. Having only embarked on her maiden voyage from Hamburg in mid-July 1939, the ES Antilla was then scuppered by the Dutch on 10 May 1940, barely 10 months later. Since then, the supine vessel has become home to such marine creatures as coral, sponges, lobsters, hawksbill sea turtles and even moray eels, making her a fascinating place to visit in a variety of ways. Last up on the snorkeling itinerary is the marvellously shallow site at Malmok Beach, just a little to the south of the shipwreck. After all that activity, prepare to reward yourself with seafood paella – freshly prepared on board – and all that an open bar can offer while you enjoy the leisurely sail back to your ship.

Please note: Guests are recommended to wear swimwear under comfortable clothing, high-factor sunscreen and to bring a towel, a camera and a hat. The tour begins with a short transfer to the marina on an open-air, Caribbean-style bus; the return route will be completed by boat. Guests must be at least 3 years of age to take part. Children must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout the tour and under their constant supervision at all times. A maximum weight restriction of 113 kg / 250 lb per guest applies. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

ARU23 – ARUBA 4X4 TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$102 PER ADULT, \$72 PER CHILD

Some of Aruba’s most popular sights, an abundance of natural beauty and plenty of photo stops await you on this enjoyable tour in a 4x4 vehicle, which you can board either as a passenger or even drive yourself. You’ll be following a friendly local guide, who will provide you with information on the island and its unique flora and fauna on the way. Among the landmarks you will stop at or pass are the early 20th-century California Lighthouse and the nearby Arashi Beach on the northwestern shore, the mid-18th century Alto Vista Chapel, the site at which Aruba’s Christianization began, and the fascinating Casibari Rock Formation, a collection of strangely shaped rocks whose exact origins continue to be shrouded in mystery. Your afternoon Aruban adventure ends with your return to the ship.

Please note: Guests wishing to drive must be in possession of a valid driving license. Guests must be at least 18 years of age in order to drive the Jeep. This tour is not recommended for guests using a wheelchair or with mobility problems. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.



CAR01HOL - CARTAGENA CITY TOUR & COFFEE TASTING WITH VEGAN SNACK



DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$62 PER ADULT, \$55 PER CHILD

Explore the city of Cartagena, which has a reputation as impenetrable after the construction of its impressive fortress. Departing from the pier, you will pass by the “Republican” architecture of the Manga residential area. Your first stop will be a photo stop at the Fort of San Felipe de Barajas, the most important work of Spanish military engineering in South America. Las Bovedas Artisan Center is next. Built as dungeons and as a means of storage, today local artisans display their work there, and you will enjoy handicraft shopping. Wander the narrow cobblestone streets and squares inside the walled city, marvel with the majestic view of San Pedro Claver, the patron saint of slaves, Plaza and church. Plaza de Bolívar is the next stop and features a statue of its namesake. Across the street we find the Inquisition Palace; the Inquisition was established in Cartagena in the year 1610 to punish any crimes against the Catholic faith. Located in this building you can see samples of jails and torture chambers. The sentencing ceremony used to take place in public, in the middle of the plaza. Continue on to the Gold Museum, enjoy viewing the impressive selection of exquisite gold pieces and pottery, as well as exhibits relating to the history of the Sinú, an ancient native people. Your tour will continue to the Navy Museum, established on 1986, and will include the restored ruins of the Jesuits school, discovery of the historic military efforts of Cartagena and the naval history of Colombia. Enjoy a local folkloric performance and a vegan snack and refreshment, Guests will visit the Santa Teresa Cluster Hotel for coffee tasting before passengers have free time to explore on your own at the old city and then return to the ship.

CAR04 - CARTAGENA WALKING TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$49 PER ADULT, \$35 PER CHILD

The tour departs from the pier in air conditioned buses, passing by the traditional district of Manga to admire the beautiful houses of the Republican Period. The walking tour starts at SANTIAGO’S BASTION. Visitors will go down the ramp and take San Juan de Dios Street, admiring the charming colonial architecture of the area and finish at the San Pedro Claver’s Plaza. The tour continues down towards Custom Plaza, which was the commercial centre during the colonial time. The walk will proceed to Plaza de la Proclamación to admire the Cathedral and the Governor’s building, which in the colonial days was used as headquarters of the Spanish government. Plaza de Bolivar will be the next stop. The tour strolls down the street admiring the magnitude of the colonial mansions in the area ending at Santiago’s Bastion. From here, the tour continues by coach to Las Bóvedas, for a 15 min. shopping stop and then to a 15 min. sightseeing drive thru Bocagrande. On the way back to the pier, guests will make a brief stop at San Felipe de Baraja’s fort for a panoramic view.

Please note: Not designed for wheelchair-bound guests or those with mobility problems. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

CAR05 - ECOLOGICAL TOUR & MANGROVE SWAMP TUNNELS

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$59 PER ADULT, \$42 PER CHILD

Your tour starts with a panoramic view of the San Felipe de Barajas Fortress, situated outside the walled city. This monumental fort is considered to be the most outstanding feat of Spanish military engineering in the new world. Its construction began in 1536 and lasted for 121 years. After a quick drive through the narrow street the walled city, you will continue to the Mangroves area. There you will be taken by canoe through mangroves tunnels to the Ciénaga de la Virgen. A great diversity of birds such as the Kingsfisher, White heron, Common Laura, Pink Spatula and Pelicans live in this area. Enjoy the beautiful flora and fauna that encompasses this fascinating eco-system.

CAR07 - PANORAMIC SIGHTSEEING TOUR

DURATION: APPROX. 2.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$52 PER ADULT, \$37 PER CHILD

This is an opportunity to experience the uniquely magnificent city of Cartagena de Indias from the comfort of your air-conditioned motor coach. Cartagena is a UNESCO World heritage site and a living breathing city that has been remarkably well-preserved. Departing from the pier side and accompanied by expert local guides, your first stop will be a panoramic



view of the imposing military fort of San Felipe de Barajas, which is situated outside the walled city. This immense building is considered to be the most outstanding feat of Spanish military engineering in the New World with its construction beginning in 1536 and lasting for 121 years. Move on to Getsemani, one of the city's historical and most storied neighbourhoods, home to lovely colonial architecture and an authentic Colombian vibe that have made it such a popular spot in recent years. You will then continue to the historic colonial city. The immense walls took 194 years to be completed and enabled Cartagena to defend itself from the numerous attacks of English pirates and other would be invaders. The Spanish colonial architecture is some of the most impressive and best preserved in South America, with its imposing merchant's houses, narrow streets, flower bedecked balconies stunning civic buildings and beautiful churches. You will continue to Bocagrande, which in complete contrast with the old city, is modern with high rise apartment complexes, hotels and restaurants. Here you will have the opportunity to visit the wonderful world of emeralds in Caribe jewelry and their Emerald museum, before returning to the port. This museum also keeps the legendary 260 pound PETRA, the largest emerald bearing vein ever unearthed in Colombia, with more than sixty crystals with terminations weighing more than two thousand carats.

CAR08 - OLD CARTAGENA, FOLKLORIC SHOW & SHOPPING 

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$65 PER ADULT, \$46 PER CHILD

This fascinating tour of the magnificent city of Cartagena de Indias, includes a tour of the historic colonial city and a beautiful show of Colombian music and dance at the painstakingly restored Heredia Theatre. Your tour starts with a panoramic view of the San Felipe de Barajas Fortress, situated outside the walled city. This monumental fort is considered to be the most outstanding feat of Spanish military engineering in the New World. On entering the walled city you will make a 10 minute stop for photographs at the San Francisco Gun Battery, and you will then have the opportunity to encounter the 16th Century first hand with the city's beautifully preserved colonial houses, churches, plazas and museums. A visit to San Pedro Claver Cloister and Monastery, built in homage to the protector of slaves, serves as a reminder of the turbulent past of Cartagena. The ornate and very beautiful Heredia Theater was built in 1911 from the ruins of the old Mercy Church to commemorate the Centennial of the independence of Colombia from Spain and has been restored as a cultural centre for theatrical and musical performances. Here a folk show of music and dance will be presented by local artists in the main auditorium. The show consists of 5 beautiful dances of three important regions of Colombia: the Atlantic Coast (Cumbia), the Pacific Coast (Currulao and Abosao), and the Los Andes region (the Market Place and the Indian Legend). You will then continue your tour to Bocagrande, the modern part of Cartagena. Here you will have the opportunity to visit the wonderful world of emeralds in Caribe jewelry and their Emerald museum, before returning to the port. This museum also keeps the legendary 260 pound PETRA, the largest emerald bearing vein ever unearthed in Colombia, with more than sixty crystals with terminations weighing more than two thousand carats.

CAR09 - CARTAGENA BY HORSE & CARRIAGE 

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$59 PER ADULT, \$42 PER CHILD

After leaving the ship, your guided tour of Cartagena begins with a photo stop at San Felipe Fortress, the largest example of Spanish military engineering in South America. Your coach then continues on to the Parque Apollo, from where you will pick up the horse and carriage that will be waiting for you. As you make your sedate way through cobblestoned streets and squares inside the walled city, you will have plenty of time to admire small details like flower-filled balconies or the glint of light escaping from colonial mansions just as much as the big things, such as the fine old buildings, many Iberian in style, and the general sense of majestic grandeur characteristic of this ancient city. A half-hour shopping break at Las Bóvedas – Cartagena's former dungeons now turned retail haven – then follows. A panoramic sightseeing tour of modern Cartagena rounds off your tour before you head back to the port and your ship.

CAR10 - EXPERIENCE MAKING JEWELRY WITH EMERALDS 

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$85 PER ADULT, \$60 PER CHILD

For a unique chance to make your own emerald cruise memento in sterling silver and leave friends at home feeling just a little green with envy, you can do no better than to join this fully guided tour to the Caribbean School of Jewelry, which



is fully approved and endorsed by the country's Education Ministry. Aided by an experienced instructor in the use of the various tools and how to go about making your piece, you will then begin the process of crafting your very own emerald-studded bling in 925 sterling silver. Next to an informative 15-minute presentation about how Colombian emeralds are extracted and cut, your 3-hour stay also includes instruction on how to melt the silver and help in making the item of jewelry of your choice, either a ring, pendant, a pair of earrings or a bracelet. When class is dismissed, you will not only receive a certificate of your newly found jewelry-making prowess, the item of jewelry that you made. You will then continue your tour to Bocagrande, the modern part of Cartagena, with its Emerald Jewelry Shop & Museum, where you will be able to browse & shop for the world famous Colombian emeralds, with a panoramic view of the San Felipe Fortress and Old city, before returning to the pier.

CAR11 – OLD CITY OF CARTAGENA AT YOUR LEISURE

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$39 PER ADULT, \$28 PER CHILD

Boasting a history that can be traced back to its foundation in 1533, modern-day Cartagena presents itself as a city of contrasts. Featuring visits to both the old walled part of the city – a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1984 – and its more modern quarters, this tour will show you some of Cartagena's best must-sees. After your coach takes you through the upmarket La Manga residential area, known for its exclusive mansions and impressive villas, and past the mid-17th-century Castillo de San Felipe, you'll be dropped off at La Marina Park and left to explore the beautiful walled city at your leisure. Soak up the historical vibe as you walk down old alleyways lined with the loveliest colonial buildings – and keep your camera at hand to take some photos to show your friends at home. As you stroll through history with ancient plazas at every turn, you might even find an authentically Colombian memento in one of the quarter's myriad shops. At the appointed time, you'll pick up your coach again at the drop-off point for a drive through the modern residential districts of Bocagrande and Castillogrande, located on a small peninsula just to the south of the walled city. From quaint old lanes to modern commerce, glitzy shops, restaurants and grand hotels: the contrast between the two worlds couldn't be more dramatic. Your tour then draws to a relaxing close with the brief return drive to the pier and your ship.

Please note: The drop-off point (La Marina Park) is also the point at which guests must pick up the coach again to return to the ship.

CAR12 – CHIVA PARTY BUS

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$59 PER ADULT, \$42 PER CHILD

This entertaining party-and-sightseeing tour begins as soon as you board the chiva bus at the pier and continues until the moment you return. Brief photo stops are scheduled at San Felipe Fortress, the bay of Manga, the bottom of La Popa hill, the districts of El Centro, Bocagrande and El Laguito, the 16th-century Castillo San Felipe de Barajas as well as Cartagena's old quarter with the vaults of Las Bóvedas. A longer stop, with time for you to stretch your legs, enjoy refreshments and local entertainment or dance to the music on the bus, is also planned at the historical Fortress of Santa Catalina. A final break is then included at the Las Bóvedas Artisan Centre, where you can browse the handicrafts and shop for a souvenir before the chiva takes you back to the pier. By the way, each bus has its own peculiar nickname so be sure to find out what yours is called before you re-board your ship.

Please note: Guests must be at least 12 years of age to take part. Children must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout the tour and under their constant supervision at all times. Guests wishing to drink alcohol must be at least 21 years of age. Guests are recommended to wear light, comfortable clothing and comfortable shoes or sandals.

CAR13 - CARTAGENA HOP ON HOP OFF

MINIMUM DURATION: APPROXIMATELY 1.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$39 PER PERSON PER CHILD

Few places on Earth are as beautiful as Cartagena, a city that offers both history and modernity. From beautiful architecture to striking monuments, there are plenty of inspiring sightseeing opportunities along our 13 stops. You can hop-on and off



our fun-filled open top double-decker bus unlimited times at any of these stops and enjoy the city at your own pace. Some of the main stops along this tour are San Felipe Castle, Walled City, The Clock Tower, Inquisition Palace, Modern City and many more. A bus will pass by any of the 13 stops every approximately 25-30 minutes. A fully guided 90-minute (optional) walk through the Walled City is included, starting and ending at stop # 12 - Bodeguita Pier.

Please note: The length of the entire tour is approximately 100 minutes, if you decide not to hop off at any of our stops. If you do choose to hop off at any of our stops, please ensure you allow ample time to return to the port.

CAR14 – COLOMBIAN COFFEE EXPERIENCE & GRADUATION IN OLD CARTAGENA

You'll then continue on to the estate for your coffee experience. Committed to educate the consumer and convinced to be able to turn them into apostles of gourmet coffee, San Alberto has designed the Coffee Extravaganza. A coffee immersion into Colombia's most awarded single estate coffee. A delight for your palate that will present a new array of surprising new flavors. Brief overview of the stages from bean to roast follow by a coffee flight prepared on 3 alternative brewing methods which will give you the opportunity to taste 3 unique coffee profiles. You will then continue to the historic colonial city. The immense walls took 194 years to be completed and enabled Cartagena to defend itself from the numerous attacks of English pirates and other would be invaders. The Spanish colonial architecture is some of the most impressive and best preserved in South America, with its imposing merchant's houses, narrow streets, flower bedecked balconies, stunning civic buildings and beautiful churches. The city is dotted with many squares and public spaces which are now home to sidewalk cafés and restaurants, with the opportunity stop for shopping before returning to the pier.

Secondly, you will enjoy a rumba (party) on board the cruise with ballerinas, a live band and an animator to light up the party. All of this while you enjoy an open bar of rum and coke, rum punch and soft drinks on board. Once we arrive at the Old City, you will take a guided walk within the city walls. You will have the chance to get to know places such as Plaza de Bolivar, Plaza San Pedro, the city's Cathedral and the main points of interest in the walled city. After the tour, you will have time to spend on your own to discover or just take in the wonders of this great place. As you return to the boat and we sail back to the cruise port, you will enjoy a marketplace where you will see a Palenquera that, with our crew's help, will give you a taste of Cartagena's typical foods, specially prepared using the vegan guidelines of the holistic group.

CRI01 – EMBERA INDIAN CULTURE**DURATION: APPROX. 6 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD**

Paradise found in its purest form. This incredible journey takes you to the jungles of Chagres, where you will encounter the Embera Indians. Our adventure begins with a 10 minute dugout canoe transfer up the Chagres River. The Embera are a unique and beautiful people. They live much as they did when Columbus arrived in the 1500's. You will soon forget the outside world as you are immersed in their cultural dance and music. During our visit, we will see that the Embera possess amazing botanical knowledge – most will be surprised to learn of their contributions to modern pharmaceuticals. We are welcome to paint our bodies as the Embera do, with a natural fruit dye called Jagua. We will also have the opportunity to view famed Embera handcrafts.

CRI02HOL - TWO OCEAN RAILROAD JOURNEY WITH VEGAN SNACK**DURATION: APPROX. 5.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$149 PER ADULT, \$105 PER CHILD**

Nowhere else in the world can you travel from one ocean to another, crossing the continent of the Americas in only an hour. This is what makes Panama an amazing country. This tour is an exotic cocktail of experiences and history all rolled-up together. Leaving from Colon City on the Caribbean Coast, famous characters and places are mentioned, and as history unfolds over time, the scenery also changes when arriving at Gatun Lake, where large vessels can be seen navigating the Panama Canal. The journey begins when we board the buses for a ride to either Gamboa Dredging Division Pier or Cucaracha Pier inside the Panama Canal, where you will take the ferry boat that will transport you through the Panama Canal. The ferry will have sufficient space for everyone. A vegan buffet lunch will be provided on board. The navigation starts through Gaylard Cut, which was the most important and difficult part of the Panama Canal construction, and is where the Continental Divide is located. After crossing Gaylard Cut, we will enter Pedro Miguel Locks on our way into Miraflores Lake. After crossing Miraflores Lake, we will enter Miraflores Lock on our way to the Pacific Ocean. Centennial and America's bridge will be seen during the adventure. You will arrive at Pacific Port that is the entrance of the Panama Canal at the Pacific Ocean. Here you will take the bus back to the ship. Each passenger will receive a commemorative certificate of doing the Panama Canal Transit and contributing to the expansion of it!

Please note: The transit of ships is subject to the local authorities. Transiting time depends on the traffic schedule of each day. In case it is needed, the tour may be operated in a different way by transiting on the Atlantic Side instead of transiting on the Pacific Side. The tour includes an approx. 1.5 hour bus ride each way.

CRI04 – PANAMA CITY TOUR**DURATION: APPROX. 6.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD**

There is only one place on earth that you can reach via the Caribbean Sea, then travel overland for an hour and leave via the Pacific Ocean: Panama City. Located at the entrance to the Panama Canal – a major feat of engineering that has now been in operation since 1914 – Panama City is not simply a pleasing blend of modern and colonial architecture, but also looks back on a long and interesting history. It was from Panama City that Francisco Pizarro launched his two unsuccessful attempts to conquer the Incan empire in Peru – once in 1524 and then again in 1526 – and Vasco Núñez de Balboa ventured out to ultimately discover the Pacific Ocean in 1513. Panama City was the first settlement to be founded on the Pacific side of the American continent, in 1519, at which time it formed a vital communication channel between Spain and



its colonies in the Pacific. This scenic visit to quaint Old Panama then continues on again by coach to Casco Antiguo, or the Colonial City. Founded in 1673, the city replaced the old capital, which at that time had already lain in ruins for 2 years after an attack of the Englishman, Captain Henry Morgan. The Casco Antiguo is full of historical buildings, which include a cathedral, the national theatre, and the fabulous Las Bóvedas walkway. As a final extra before returning you to the ship, the tour also includes a quick visit to Agua Claras Locks (Expansion Center) to see how the Panama Canal operates. Please note: This tour includes a long route by bus. As the transit of ships through the lock is subject to local authority permission and is dependent on daily scheduling, no guarantee can be given that any ships will be passing through the lock at the time of your visit. The order of the visits may vary.

CRI06 - KAYAKING ON LAKE GATUN 

DURATION: APPROX. 3.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$69 PER ADULT, \$49 PER CHILD

Take a break from your ship, board a coach and enjoy the drive to your main stop, the Hotel Melia Panama Canal, which forms the starting point of your kayaking adventure on Lake Gatun. This exhilarating experience is sure to appeal to guests of an adventurous persuasion, who enjoy physical exercise and love the great outdoors. Nature's bounty in the form of stunning scenery and an abundance of wildlife is evident at every turn as you explore the area from the watery vantage point of your kayak – without doubt the best seat in the house. The tour will include a kayak ride around the wildlife of Gatun Lake.

Please note: Guests must be at least 8 years of age to participate and are recommended to be physically fit. As you are likely to get wet during the kayaking activity, you are recommended to bring a change of clothes, wear swimwear, sunscreen, a sunhat, sandals and bring a towel.

CRI08HOL - MONKEY WATCH AT GAMBOA WITH VEGAN SNACK 

DURATION: APPROX. 5 HOURS | PRICE: \$92 PER ADULT, \$65 PER CHILD

A natural adventure of sight and sound, combined with the thrill of spending through the Panama Canal next to the mighty ships transiting this man-made wonder! After an exhilarating 30 minute ride at high speed right through the heart of the Panama Canal, the boat will slow down and enter the labyrinth of jungle-covered islands of Lake Gatun. In this protected area the wildlife is plentiful and you are likely to encounter capuchin monkeys, 3-toed sloth, howler monkeys, various kinds of toucans and other birds as well as caimans, crocodiles, turtles and a wealth of butterflies. This is an exceptional place to experience the sight and sounds of the jungle up close. Our trained naturalist guides will ensure that you have an outstanding nature experience by tracing the wildlife as well as educating you about it and its habitat throughout this exceptional jungle and canal adventure. A vegan snack and bottled water is included.

CRI09 - PANAMA OLD QUARTER 

DURATION: APPROX. 4.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$75 PER ADULT, \$53 PER CHILD

With numerous fascinating sites and a history intertwined with Spain, France and the United States that never fails to delight, Casco Viejo (Old Compound) offers highlights that include the 17th century churches, the ruins of century convents and residences, original dungeons, a French monument to the 22,000 who died building the Panama Canal and the Panama Canal Museum in an elegant, restored building that once housed the headquarters of the French company that attempted to build a sea level canal.

CRI12 - PANAMA CANAL EXPANSION 

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$92 PER ADULT, \$65 PER CHILD

Hailed as a major feat of early 20th-century civil engineering and one of the most challenging building projects ever undertaken, the Panama Canal served to revolutionize global shipping when it was inaugurated, after 10 solid years of construction work, in 1914. Removing the need to navigate either around the notoriously hazardous Cape Horn in the south of Chile or the equally tricky Strait of Magellan, the 48-mile ship canal provided an easily navigable link between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans via the Caribbean Sea. Your trip to this iconic structure begins with a short drive to the waterway's Expansion Observatory Platform to learn a little about the current construction project that aims to add



capacities for a larger shipping lane by building a new and bigger set of locks. This experience at the canal will give you the opportunity to see the former Canal Zone, residential and military facilities that were built by the USA at the beginning of the last century. Your fascinating tour of the Panama Canal then comes to a close with your return to the ship.

CRI14 – ECO CRUISE ON GATUN LAKE

DURATION: APPROX. 3.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$95 PER ADULT, \$67 PER CHILD

Forming a large part of the Panama Canal, Gatun Lake is one of the country's major transport routes, but equally a place of great natural beauty and your destination on this leisurely tour. An approx. 20-minute air-conditioned drive will first take you to the Meliá Resort, after which you'll have time to stretch your legs before you board the boat for the 1.5-hour eco-cruise. Created when the Gatun Dam was constructed in the early 20th century, Gatun Lake is surrounded by rainforest with the usual jungle crowd: exotic birds, monkeys, sloths, iguanas, crocodiles and more. You'll be heading for one of the lake's most secluded spots to savour this natural splendour first-hand. The experience promises to be particularly rewarding thanks to information provided by your tour guide on the animals and their various habitats. Following your lake cruise, you'll go on a rainforest walk and follow the eco-trail that surrounds the lake, while your nature guide points out wildlife and shares details on habitat. The coach transfer back to the ship then gives you time to relax.

Please note: Guests are recommended to wear light, comfortable clothing and comfortable walking shoes.

CRI15 – BIOMUSEO: DESIGNED BY FRANK GEHRY

DURATION: APPROX. 5.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD

Also known as the "Biodiversity Museum: Panama Bridge of Life", the new Biomuseo in Panama City is one of the brightest – and most colourful – jewels to appear on the urban landscape of this major metropolis. The Canadian-born star architect, Frank Gehry, masterminded the innovative design of the building, which counts as his first work in Latin America. The 8 permanent galleries of the museum provide a fascinating insight into how life on our planet changed forever when the Isthmus of Panama emerged many millions of years ago. The museum visit will be followed by a drive-by tour of the Causeway of Amador and Panama City, via Cinta Costera. As a final highlight, you'll also get a look at the Bridge of the Americas, which spans the Pacific entrance to the Panama Canal and connects the land masses of North and South America. Your outing then comes to a close with your return to the pier and your ship.

Please note: Guests must be at least 10 years of age to take part. Children must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout the tour and under their constant supervision at all times. Guests are further recommended to wear comfortable clothing, comfortable shoes, high-factor sunscreen and insect repellent as well as to bring a camera.

After leaving the ship and boarding an air-conditioned coach, a short journey will take you to this exclusive Caribbean getaway and its glorious golden sands. You'll be met on arrival and shown around the facilities available to you at the resort, which include an open national bar, a beach volleyball area, beach chairs, a beach party area and a chance to go kayaking. A vegan sandwich and fruit is also included. Further resort amenities that you can use at extra cost are a restaurant, souvenir store and snorkeling straight from the beach. Spend as long as you like enjoying the wonderful resort complex and the beach; when you're ready to leave, simply catch one of the regular shuttle buses to get back to the pier and your ship.

Please note: All guests must be seated all the time while the bus is moving. Please follow the safety instructions provided by your guides. Additional food can be purchased at extra cost while at the resort. Cash only in either US dollars or Mexican pesos will be accepted. There will be regular opportunities to return to the cruise ship pier throughout your stay. The shuttle service is dependent on the availability of transportation. The resort also features water sports facilities, which you can frequent/hire at additional cost not covered by the price of the tour. Guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. The tour is suitable for guests with mobility problems. Only adults over the age of 21 can drink alcohol from the National Open Bar. After meeting your guide when you leave the ship, you'll make your way to Fisherman's Pier to board the catamaran. A safety briefing will be given and fully certified divers will remain on hand throughout the sail to ensure your safety at all times. You'll also be kitted out with a life vest, which you will be requested to wear while on board and in the water, plus a brand new snorkel tube for reasons of hygiene. You can first savour wonderful views as you sail out; then, when your catamaran drops anchor, marvel at the colourful world under the sea, where jacks, snappers, angelfish, queen triggerfish, groupers and even turtles can be found rubbing shoulders – or perhaps dorsal fins – in a spirit of (mostly) peaceful coexistence. Once the catamaran sets sail again, your on-board guides will continue to entertain you. Finally, you'll be free to go straight back to the ship when you arrive back on dry land or remain in town and make your own way back when you're ready. As use of all necessary equipment is included in the price of the tour, you won't have anything to carry around with you if you do choose to have a look around town.

Your transport back to the ship will depart from Fisherman's Pier at a designated time. Guests wishing to stay in town for longer will have to return to the ship at their own expense. Wave to the people as you then move on and keep a lookout for the area's fabulous birdlife and resident iguanas as you travel off road to a beach club. Take full advantage of the ample facilities, leaving you only with the problem of choosing what to do. Fancy soaking up the rays in a comfortable sun chair while sipping a delicious drink and snacking on something tasty? No problem! Or would you rather swim in the Caribbean Sea, have a go at beach volleyball or explore the spacious beach? Go for it – or simply do them all. Plenty of time will be yours to do whatever you fancy before you begin the drive



back to the pier and your ship.

Please note: Due to the driving involved, the tour is strictly alcohol-free. Food can be purchased at extra cost while at Cacum's Beach. Cash and credit card accepted. Guests must be at least 6 years of age to take part. Guests wishing to drive must be at least 21 years of age and in possession of a valid driving license. Occupancy per beach buggy: 4 guests. All buggies feature an automatic transmission. Presence of seaweed in the Mexican Caribbean Coast is seasonal and could be present in the water and during the off road tour.

Continue this tour inland to visit "The Place of the Red Corn", Chacchoben, and learn about the fascinating Mayan culture from our knowledgeable guides during the journey. Enjoy a guided tour of this unique archaeological site set in beautiful surroundings still partially covered by the rain forest. Climb to the top of the "Gran Basamento" taking you above the tree line, and visit two sacred temples. Before leaving, you will have the opportunity to buy souvenirs from shops on site. Your journey continues to your vegan buffet lunch waiting for you at our Beach Club. After your meal, sunbathe on a sun lounger, relax in a hammock, take a swim in the ocean and enjoy all complimentary drinks including your favorite cocktails. Feeling fully relaxed, well fed and in good spirits, your transfer awaits to return you to the ship.

CMY24 - OFF-ROAD JEEP & BEACH TOUR



DURATION: APPROX. 3.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$99 PER ADULT, \$70 PER CHILD

Exciting, entertaining and a great way to spend some time off the ship, this tour will see you board and possibly drive a jeep to discover some of the roads less travelled along the mesmerising Costa Maya. Once you've settled into your 4-person jeep - with one of your number doing the driving - you'll head out in convoy, first through the pretty little fishing village of Mahahual and then off road into the lush rainforest that flanks the coastline. With sublime views of the Caribbean Sea, stretches of sandy beach and tiny villages to enjoy on the way, your 1-hour drive will take you south to reach Explora Beach. Pristine sands and a secluded location make this ideal spot to stop for a delicious Mexican-style lunch, followed by time to do whatever you please. The water is just the place for a refreshing dip, the beach perfect for working on your tan, playing beach volleyball or going for a stroll, and the stunning surroundings are well worth a photo or two. You'll return to the pier and your ship in the same way you came - by jeep. The only thing left to decide is: who gets to have fun driving on the way back?

Please note: All jeeps feature a manual transmission (stick shift) and each jeep seats 4. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable shoes and swimwear under their clothing as well as to bring a towel, a hat, high-factor sunscreen and some cash to pay for any additional purchases. Guests wishing to drive must be at least 21 years of age and in possession of a valid driving license. Guests must be at least 3 years of age to take part in the tour. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for pregnant women and guests with pre-existing back/neck injuries. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

CMY26 - GLASS-BOTTOMED BOAT & SNORKEL TOUR



DURATION: APPROX. 2.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$69 PER ADULT, \$49 PER CHILD

Since the waters off the Costa Maya boast the world's second-largest coral reef, it would be rather a shame to miss out on seeing it at first hand - and if you prefer, without even getting your feet wet. After the short transfer from the pier to the lovely beach at Mahahual, a small fishing village just south of the cruise ship terminal, you'll board a glass-bottomed boat and begin your adventure. With the iridescent waters of the Caribbean Sea beneath you and panoramic views to soothe the eye, you'll sail to the reef location. After taking some time to get acquainted with the teeming wildlife through the boat's glass underbelly, you can - if you want - take to the water itself to meet and greet the reef's colourful inhabitants. Thanks to the small group size, you can feel safe in knowing that your fully qualified guides will remain close at hand throughout your snorkel tour to assist you at every turn. Once you return to the beach at Mahahual, you can choose whether to return straight to the ship or if you'd prefer to have a look around downtown and then return on your own steam.



Please note: Guests must be at least 8 years of age to take part. For safety reasons, the tour is considered to be unsuitable for pregnant women, guests with pre-existing respiratory conditions such as asthma, with cardiac conditions (including a history of cardiac arrest and/or surgery), diabetes, epilepsy, back/neck injuries and guests taking medication such as antidepressants, lithium, beta-blockers and base vein constrictors. Guests wishing to remain downtown after the tour will have to return to the ship at their own expense. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

CMY28 – KOHUNLICH MAYAN RUINS   

DURATION: APPROX. 6.5 HOURS | PRICE: \$79 PER ADULT, \$59 PER CHILD

Situated on the Yucatán Peninsula and one of Mexico's absolute must-sees is the archaeological site of Kohunlich, a terraced city built by the Mayans between approx. A.D. 250 and A.D. 600. The site's unusual-sounding name is derived from the English name of the cohune palm, a common sight in the area. Your tour of cultural discovery begins with an air-conditioned coach ride, during which a bilingual guide will entertain you with information on the Mayan remains ahead. At the site itself, you'll be escorted through the park-like setting of the historical complex, whose highlights include a sunken palace, an acropolis, courtyards and even an ancient ceremonial ball field. But the site's main attraction is undoubtedly the Temple of the Masks, dedicated to the Mayan sun god KinichAhau. Although the oversized stucco masks on either side of the temple's central staircase are easy enough to see from the ground, you'll have to climb up the pyramid-like structure to get a closer look. Parts of the stucco – which dates back to earlier than A.D. 500 – still retain some of their original colour. With memories of the beautifully secluded Kohunlich fresh in your mind, you'll then get to enjoy a light packed lunch on the coach journey back to the Costa Maya and your ship.

Please note: The tour involves a 2-hour coach drive each way without a comfort stop; guests are therefore recommended to use the facilities prior to departure. As the tour involves longer periods of walking on uneven ground, guests are requested to take extra care. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests with mobility problems or using a wheelchair. Guests are recommended to wear high-factor sunscreen, insect repellent and comfortable shoes. Depending on the exchange rate on the day of the tour, a fee of US\$5-US\$8 will be payable by guests wishing to use video equipment (including mobile phones) at the archaeological site. The site does not permit the use of tripods, professional video equipment or flash photography. The tour also involves an approx. 5-minute walk between the car park and the entrance of Kohunlich.

CMY29 – JAGUAR TRUCK: MAYAN ADVENTURE EXPEDITION 

DURATION: APPROX. 4 HOURS | PRICE: \$79 PER ADULT, \$56 PER CHILD

What's black and red and built for fun? The Jaguar Truck – your specially equipped mode of transport on a tour dedicated to delivering an entertaining and varied adventure with plenty of time in the great outdoors. After boarding the truck, your first stop is scheduled following an only 15-minute drive. You can then either team up with a fellow guest to ride a tandem or simply walk through the rainforest to reach your destination: a beautiful Mexican cenote. The deliciously refreshing water is perfect for a soak, after which you'll get back on the truck and head for your next stop: the beach. While your friendly tour guides get busy setting up camp, you'll have time to practice boogie boarding or stand-up paddle boarding, take a floatation tube for a dip in the sea or simply relax on the fine white sand. Once you've enjoyed lunch on the beach, your return journey in the customised Jaguar Truck will give you a chance to enjoy further gorgeous views of the Costa Maya coastline.

Please note: The tour is designed for guests who enjoy high-level outdoor activities. Guests will be required to fill out and sign a waiver/release form. Guests wishing to take part must weigh no more than 320 lbs/145 kg. At a maximum depth of 4 ft./1.2 m, the cenote is a safe environment even for guests who are not strong swimmers. Guests must be at least 8 years of age to take part and are generally recommended to wear a hat, comfortable shoes, light clothing (that can get wet while paddle boarding), apply sunscreen and insect repellent (from August to December) as well as to bring a change of clothing and a towel.



CMY30 – SALSA COOKING, DANCING & BEACH BREAK

DURATION: APPROX. 3 HOURS | PRICE: \$85 PER ADULT, \$62 PER CHILD

Since there's no better place on earth than Mexico itself to find out how authentic Mexican food is made, move your hips to the salsa beat and sip a refreshing margarita while you dance, this tour lets you go native for a while and do all three in the most sumptuous surroundings. A coach transfer to a beachfront restaurant affording superb views of the Caribbean Sea gets the party started, after which you'll first be shown the best way to make Mexican salsas and creamy guacamole – delicious with tortilla chips whichever way you slice and dice it. And the recipe will be yours to keep as a memento so you can recreate the moment back at home. Then tickle your taste buds with a complimentary margarita, a cool Mexican beer or some flavoured water before you hit the dance floor for your salsa lesson. Simply follow the step-by-step instructions and you'll soon be swaying to the infectious rhythms like a pro. Free time will then be yours to relax and enjoy the beach facilities, laze around in the sun or go for a swim in the sea. Best of all, you can choose between returning to the ship using the transport provided or stay for longer and use a taxi coupon for your return trip.

Please note: Taxi coupons will be issued so guests can return to the ship at their leisure. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests with mobility problems or who use mobility aids such as a cane, walker or a wheelchair. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable shoes and wear (or bring) swimwear under their clothes as well as to bring a change of clothes, a towel, a hat, sunscreen and some cash to cover the cost of any additional purchases. Guests will be required to sign a waiver that may only be available in English.

CMY37 – MAYÁ: LOST MAYAN KINGDOM ADVENTURE PARK

Designed to deliver bags of fun for the entire family, this tour takes you off the ship and transfers you to a one-of-a-kind adventure park: "Mayá: Lost Mayan Kingdom". The themed landscaped grounds feature 9 exciting waterslides, 2 zip line circuits and the winding Kukulcan zip coaster course. Apart from enjoying such adrenaline-fuelled activities, the park is also ideal for relaxing at the pool or natural cenote, or taking a leisurely inner-tube ride through the Mayan jungle setting on the River Expedition. You can stay at the park for as long as you like, but be sure to pay the gift and photo shops a visit to take home lasting memories of your visit before you take the shuttle back to the ship.

Please note: A gift shop, photo shop, locker rental as well as food and beverages are available on site at additional cost not covered by the price of the tour. The park operates a strict no alcohol policy for reasons of safety. As the outing involves climbing and longer periods of walking on uneven ground, guests are required to be in good physical health and to take their own personal medical history into account before taking part. The tour is not available for pregnant women or guests with heart/respiratory problems, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, a history of seizures, neck/back injuries, or those who have recently undergone surgery or who suffer from any other medical conditions. Guests younger than 18 years of age must be accompanied by a paying adult throughout the tour. Guests must weigh no more than 240 lbs/109 kg to take part. Guests are recommended to wear water shoes, comfortable clothing, sunglasses, a hat, insect repellent and high-factor sunscreen while at the park. The tour duration totals 3 hours at minimum, but guests can stay for longer and take a shuttle bus back to the ship.

Enjoy an exclusive outing to the Mayan ruins of Chacchoben, with beer, soft drinks and bottled water served on both the drive there and the journey back. This tour is designed for small groups of maximum 12 guests, having in mind your desire for exclusivity and comfort. On arrival at the archaeological site, you'll spend 2 hours being taken on a guided tour of the fascinating ruins. The historical and cultural significance of the various structures and buildings found at the site, including the Gran Basamento staircase leading to the top of the largest pyramid, will be explained by your guide during your visit. Keep your camera at hand during your time at this important archaeological excavation. Lastly, you can relax on the scenic coach ride back to the ship.

Please note: The tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests of limited mobility. Guests with impaired vision or hearing must be accompanied by a paying assistant, friend or family member as well as an interpreter (for guests who are hard of hearing). A short drive from the cruise terminal will take you to Miami’s Big Bus Central Station, from where you will have your choice of two exciting loops; the Miami Beach Loop or the City Loop. Each loop is approximately 90 minutes from start to finish. You’ll be free to hop off and on again at any one of the 25 stops along each route, with buses running at intervals of about 30 minutes. All routes end at the Big Bus Central Station at the Bayside Marketplace. Return whenever you like to suit your flight schedule and catch the shuttle to your respective airport, with some lovely memories to take with you as you fly home.

Please note: This tour is available (1) for guests booked on flights departing from Miami International Airport after 2 pm to destinations within the USA or after 3 pm to international destinations, (2) for guests booked on flights departing from Ft.
